比赛项目

本次大赛只设混合团体赛一项，每场团体赛由三场单项比赛构成，依次为：女双、男双、混双。

参赛资格

- o 所有参赛选手须为毕业于中国、加拿大各高校或其他国家知名大学的校友

组队要求

- o 每支队伍须由 5 至 8 名队员组成
- o 每位选手仅限参加一个团体队伍并不得兼项，只有一名女选手允许兼打女双和混双项；配偶双方均为高校校友的夫妻允许两人一起加入其中一方所在的校队。
- o 每所高校参赛队伍数量不限
- o 若单一校友会人员不足，允许两或三校联合组队参赛
- o 报名截止后，不得更换队员

比赛安排

本次比赛采用国际匹克球联合会（IPF）认可的标准比赛规则分小组循环赛和单淘汰赛两个阶段进行，全部比赛均采用每球得分，每局 21 分，一局定胜制

第一阶段：小组循环赛，先得 21 分者胜。任何一方达到 20 分时，必须持有发球权方能获得第二十一分（金球）。所有球队均晋级到下一阶段比赛

第二阶段：单败淘汰赛，任何一方获得 20 分后，必须持有发球权方能继续得分，一方必须领先另一方 2 分方能获胜；若 24：24，先得第二十五分者获胜

More than just a sporting event, the tournament serves as a bridge for building friendships and encouraging the development of pickleball among university alumni communities.

EVENT

There is 1 event, mixed team, only. Each inter-team match consists of three matches in the following order: 1. Women's Doubles, 2. Men's Doubles, Mixed Doubles.

ELIGIBILITY

All participants have to be alumni of higher education institute of China, Canada or known university from other countries.

TEAM FORMATION

Each team consists of 5~8 members.

Each player can join ONE team only. All players on a team are allowed play one match only except one female player who is allowed to play two matches of Women's Doubles and Mixed Doubles. A couple (husband and wife), is allowed to join a team together into a university team either spouse belongs to.

Each college/university can enter as many teams as they can.

A united team can be form by one, two or three colleges/universities.

The members of a team can not be changed after the deadline of registration.

COMPETITION RULES

The rules of International Pickleball Federation will be applied. The competitions will have 2 stages: group round robin and single eliminations. All games will be rally-scoring, 21 points per game, 1 game determines the winner.

- Stage 1: Group round robin. First to 21 points wins. When either team reaches 20 points, they must hold the serve for the twenty-first point. All teams advance to the next stage.
- Stage 2: Single-elimination, after either team has scored 20 points, they must hold the serve to continue scoring, and one team must be 2 points ahead of the other to win; if 24:24, the first to score 25 points wins.
